1 The Chairman welcomed Mr. Paul Cheetham, in his capacity as the Eardisley representative of the Patient Participation Group of the Kington Medical Practice, who then gave a report to the Parish Council.

- The new Kington Medical Centre should be started soon and completed before the end of 2011. Contractor – Vinci.
- Eardisley surgery is to be bought from Herefordshire Council by Kington Medical Centre. There had been an issue re. ownership and use of the existing car-park but this has now been resolved and more car-parking will be created for the surgery.
- There were many questions about the purchase of Eardisley surgery and any possible conditions/covenants/restrictions imposed by Herefordshire Council regarding future use. Several Councillors wanted a guarantee that the Practice would continue in Eardisley and the building would not be sold in the future for residential use. Mr Cheetham said that there were no plans to close Eardisley surgery.
- County Cllr. John Hope said he would go back to the Council and seek further clarification about any conditions of sale
- Practice information booklet has now been received by all households
- Another doctor – Dr Corbett has joined the Practice making 5 doctors in all.

Village halls can have 2 green wheelie bins for recycling, should be delivered in February.

Replacement culvert at the Rhydspence cost £18,000.

It was **AGREED** to sign up for the P3 scheme (1 vote against)
